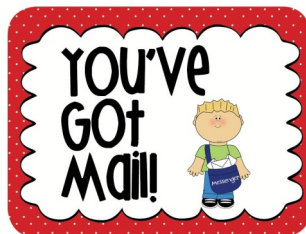
Good News Club Rally
